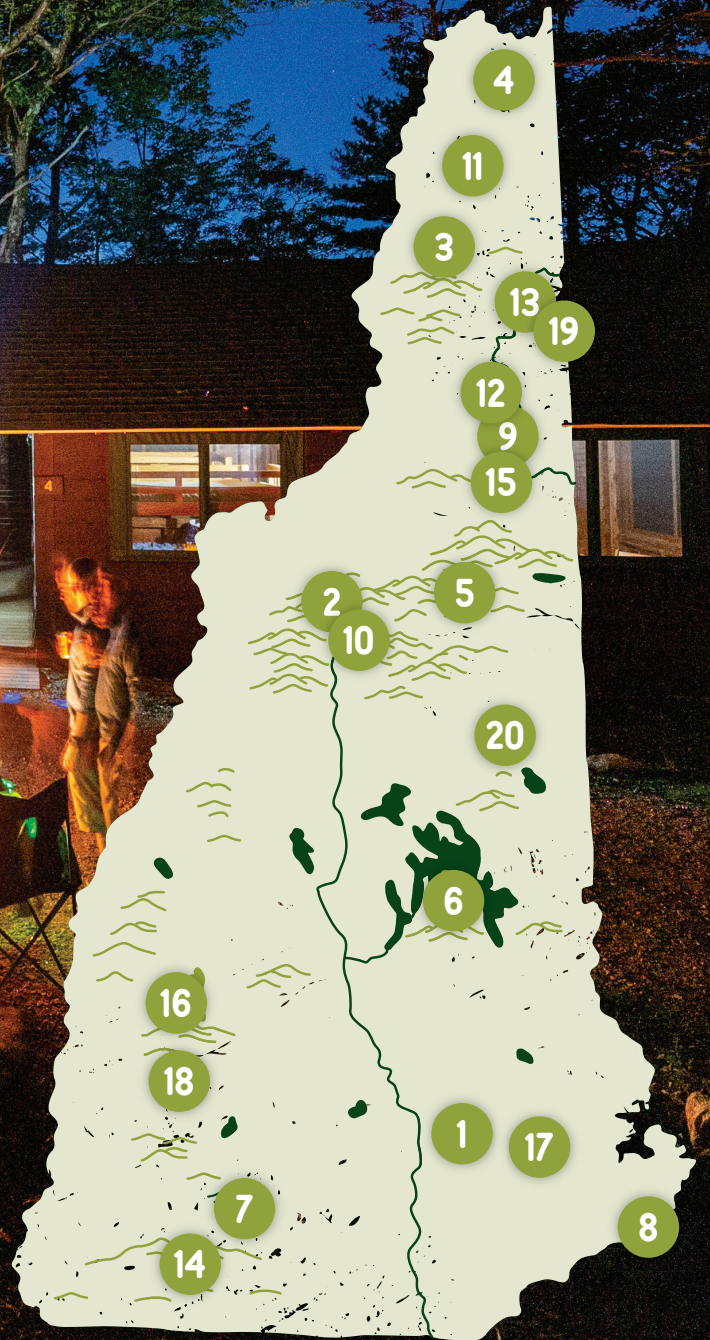

GUIDE TO NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE PARKS CAMPGROUNDS

1 BEAR BROOK STATE PARK

Allenstown • 101 sites



This 10,000-acre park has forty miles of trails leading to marshes, bogs, summits and ponds, for hikers, mountain bikers and equestrians to roam.

2 CANNON MOUNTAIN RV PARK

Franconia • 7 sites



This year-round park offers full-hookup campsites at the north end of the State Park. Winter services limited.

3 COLEMAN STATE PARK

Stewartstown • 25 sites



Located on Little Diamond Pond, this is an excellent base for fishing, kayaking, hunting, ATV camping and more.

THE LODGES AT COLEMAN STATE PARK

Located within the park, four cabins and five lodges are available to rent year-round and is an ideal destination for ATV and snowmobile enthusiasts.

4 DEER MOUNTAIN CAMPGROUND

Pittsburg • 15 sites



This primitive campground is located just south of the Canadian border and offers great opportunities for wildlife viewing.

5 DRY RIVER CAMPGROUND

Hart's Location • 38 sites



This riverside campground is positioned in the center of many trail heads in Crawford Notch State Park.

6 ELLACOYA STATE PARK

Gilford • 38 sites



These full-hookup sites on the shore of Lake Winnepesaukee offer mountain views.

7 GREENFIELD STATE PARK

Greenfield • 257 sites



Tucked in the southwest corner of the Granite State, this 400-acre park features ponds and bogs.

8 HAMPTON BEACH RV PARK

Hampton • 78 sites



This campground is located at the mouth of the Hampton River at the edge of the Atlantic Ocean.

9 JERICHO MOUNTAIN STATE PARK

Berlin • 20 sites



This campground includes ATV sites and cabins, with a day-use area and 75+ miles of OHRV trails.

10 LAFAYETTE PLACE CAMPGROUND

Franconia • 97 sites



In the heart of Franconia Notch State Park this campground is a great base for exploring the White Mountains Region.

11 LAKE FRANCIS STATE PARK

Pittsburg • 47 sites (10 with hookups)



This lakefront park offers tent and ATV camping, including 10 water/electric hookups. The park offers an excellent base for fishing, wildlife viewing and kayaking.

12 MILAN HILL STATE PARK

Milan • 10 sites



With sweeping views of the White Mountains, this primitive campground offers 10 campsites including four yurts.

13 MOLLIDGEWOCK STATE PARK

Errol • 45 sites



Bankside to the Androscoggin River, this park is a favorite of canoe and kayak enthusiasts.

14 MONADNOCK STATE PARK

Jaffrey • 40 sites (4 with hookups)



The Gilson Pond Campground offers hike-to sites. The campground at the Monadnock headquarters is open year-round.

15 MOOSE BROOK STATE PARK

Gorham • 59 sites



Ideally located for Presidential Range hiking and fishing in the Peabody and Moose Rivers, the many trails in the park are great for exploring on foot or mountain bike.

16 MOUNT SUNAPEE STATE PARK

Newbury • 11 sites



The campground includes five lean-to sites and five platform sites to enjoy the State Beach on Lake Sunapee.

17 PAWTUCKAWAY STATE PARK

Nottingham • 193 sites



Lining the shore of beautiful Pawtuckaway Lake, this campground includes cabins and group sites.

18 PILLSBURY STATE PARK

Washington • 41 sites



Set within a 4,500-acre preserve, this park includes canoe-to and walk-to sites and several ponds and wetlands to see a variety of wildlife.

19 UMBAGOG LAKE STATE PARK

Cambridge • 71 sites



With tent, electric/water hookups sites, remote sites and cabins, this park is great for wildlife viewing and offers easy access to the Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge.

20 WHITE LAKE STATE PARK

Tamworth • 202 sites



Located on the shore of White Lake, this park has family group sites, and some of the best swimming in the region.
