

Coleman State Park

Camping Information

The park is located on Diamond Pond Road in Stewartstown, 12 miles east of Colebrook off Route 26. Coleman offers 22 sites and 4 camper cabins adjacent to Little Diamond Pond. The campsites can accommodate most camping equipment including self-contained RV's; however there are no hook-ups available. The campground is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day Weekend through October 15th. First come/first serve, walk-ins are welcome. ATV trails are accessible right from the campground.

Fully-furnished lodges are also available to rent within Coleman State Park. Each lodge is available year-round. One can hold up to 12 people and the others can hold up to 8 people each. The Marten Room located in the Main Lodge can accommodate up to 4 people.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

Coin-operated showers, flush toilets, a boat launch, and a dump station are available. Water is not available after mid-October.

Activities

The excellent trout fishing in Little Diamond Pond makes Coleman a great location for fishermen. It is also a good base for fall hunting. Other activities include hiking, canoeing, snowmobiling, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and ATVing on nearby trails.

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Making a Reservation

Reservations may be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757 or online at nhstateparks.org. Reservations for organized youth group camping should be made by calling the Concord Office at (603) 271-3556. Youth group reservations are not available online.

About the Policies

- All guests, including those with reservations, must register at the office. Campground check-out is 11 am and check-in is 1 pm or later. Cabins and Marten Room check-out is 10 am and check-in is 3 pm.
- Payment is due upon registration and must be made by U.S. funds. Only cash or traveler's check are accepted.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Pets are permitted in the campground, but must be leashed and attended at all times.
- Envelopes for registration are located at the selfregistration station at the start of the campground road loop. Please fill in the information requested on the envelope, enclose the fee, and deposit in the designated slot.
- Cutting standing trees and shrubs and the use of power saws is prohibited.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations or quarantined counties of NH (Belknap, Hillsborough, Merrimack and Rockingham) (RSA 227-K:17).
