# **Camping Information**

#### About the RV Park

The 38-site RV park is located on the southwest shore of Lake Winnipesaukee, New Hampshire's largest lake. The campground is open May through October

### Facilities, Services and Amenities

The park includes an 600-foot long sandy beach, common campfire pits, laundry room, bathhouse, and a panoramic view of the Ossipee and Sandwich mountains.

#### **Activities**

Campers enjoy Lakes Region attractions, swimming, picnicking, boating, and nearby hiking trails.

#### About the Policies

- Campers with a reservation must register at the campground office. Check-in begins at 1 pm. Check-out time is 11 am.
- Payment is made online when making reservations.
  The Park Office does not make advance reservations but can make walk-in reservations. Payments at check-in are made by cash, credit card, gift card, or check.
- You <u>must</u> be able to hook up to water, sewer, and electricity.
- Pets are not permitted anywhere in the campground or park.
- A maximum of three vehicles per site, including camping unit, is allowed. Motorcycles and/or carriers count as a vehicle.
- Only breathable weave mats are allowed on sites.
- No clotheslines or drying racks allowed.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Tents or auxiliary shelters are not permitted.
- Boats, trailers, and visitors <u>must</u> park on the boat launch road.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. Please do not bring firewood from out-of-state locations.

# For Your Safety

Do not invite raccoons, ducks, or other wild animals to the beach or campground. Keep the park clean by disposing of food waste in the park dumpsters and securing all food items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons. Feeding the ducks attracts large numbers to the swimming area, where they become a health concern. Bread has no nutritional value for waterfowl.
