Camping Information

About the RV Park

The 38-site RV park is located on the southwest shore of Lake Winnepesaukee, New Hampshire's largest lake. The campground is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

The park includes an 800-foot long sandy beach, a common campfire pit, park store, laundromat, bathhouse, nearby attractions and a panoramic view of the Ossipee and Sandwich mountains.

Activities

Campers enjoy nearby attractions, swimming, picnicking, and boating.

About the Policies

- All campers, including those with a reservation, must register at the campground office between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11 am.
- Payment is due upon registration and may be made by cash, voucher, money order, Mastercard, Visa, or Discover.
- You must be able to hook up to water and electricity.
- Pets are not permitted in the campground.
- A maximum of three vehicles per site, including camping unit, is allowed. Motorcycles and/or carriers count as a vehicle.
- Only breathable weave mats are allowed on sites.
- No clotheslines or drying racks allowed.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Tents or auxiliary shelters are not permitted.
- Boats, trailers, and visitors must park on the boat launch road.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Feeding the ducks attracts large numbers to the swimming area where they become a health concern.
