

Jericho Mountain State Park

Camping Information

About the Campground

The park is located on Jericho Lake Road, off Route 110, approximately 3 miles west of downtown Berlin. Jericho Mountain offers 5 rustic cabins, 2 Adirondack style camping lean-to's and 13 campsites near Jericho Lake. All cabins and campsites are available by advance reservation. The campground is open from mid-May to mid-November, weather permitting.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

Pit toilets and water faucets are available throughout the campground. The day-use area offers a swimming beach, boat launch, picnic sites and a shelter.

About the Policies

- Check-in time is between 1 pm and 6 pm (call ahead if arriving late). Check-out time is 11 am. Campers are welcome to use the day-use area for the remainder of the day.
- Payment is due upon registration and must be US funds. Only cash and traveler's checks are accepted.
- Visitors are required to pay day-use fees and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am, but noise levels must be kept reasonable at all times.
- Pets are permitted in the campground, not in the beach area. Pets must be leashed and attended to at all times.
- Although there are no hook-ups, recreational vehicles are welcome in sites where they fit.
- Do not wash dishes or brush teeth at water faucets, please carry water back to your site for this purpose.
- The campground is not considered an ATV riding area, only the use of the designated roads and driveways is permitted to access riding trails from campsites.
- The campground speed limit is 10 mph.
- If the campground office is closed, registration at the self-registration station is required. Provide the requested information on the envelope provided, enclose the fee, and deposit in the designated slot.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).

Activities

The campground is located near popular areas for hiking, fishing, canoeing, kayaking, wildlife viewing, hunting, and ATViing. From this lakeside campground you enjoy remarkable views of the surrounding mountains. Campers can ride directly from a campsite onto the extensive network of ATV trails throughout the over 7,000 acres of park property, as well as direct connection to the Ride the Wilds 1,000+ miles of regionwide trails.

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.
