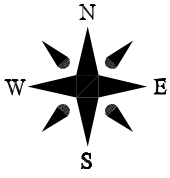


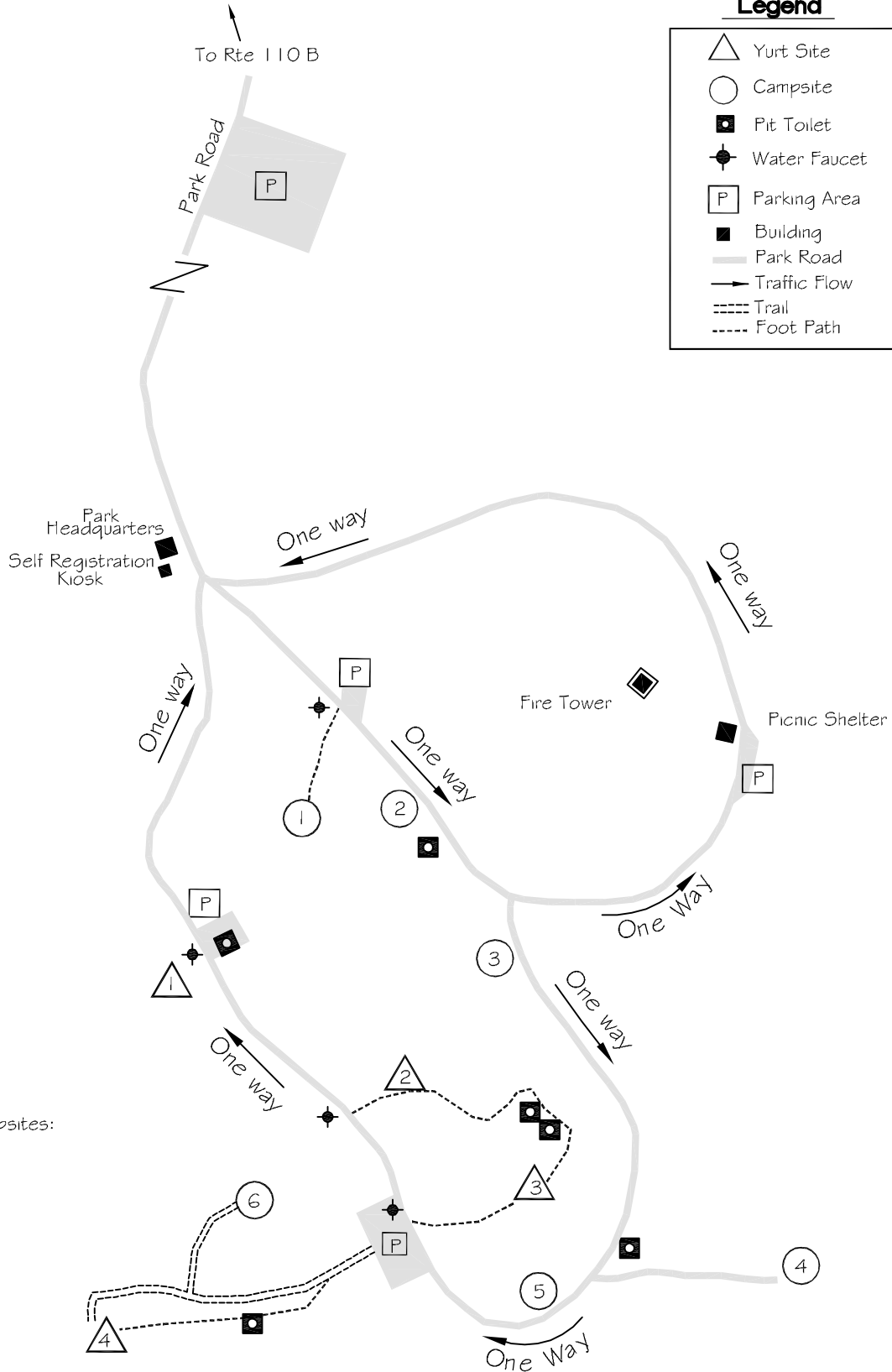
# MILAN HILL STATE PARK CAMPGROUND

# Milan Hill State Park

## Camping Information

### About the Campground

The campground is open from mid May to mid to late October, weather permitting. The park is located on Route 110B off of Route 16, approximately 10 miles north of Berlin.

### Facilities, Services and Amenities

The campground offers 4 yurts available by advanced reservation only and 6 campsites of which 3 are also reservable. Pit toilets and water faucets are available throughout the campground loop. The day-use area offers a picnic shelter, hilltop picnic sites, and a fire tower.

### Activities

The campground is located near popular areas for fishing, canoeing, kayaking, wildlife viewing, hunting, and ATViing. From this hilltop campground, and the firetower located there, you can get a complete view of mountain ranges in New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont, and Canada.

### About the Policies

- Check-in is between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11am.
- Payment is due upon registration at the self-registration kiosk and may be made by cash, voucher, money order, or traveler's check.
- Day-use visitors are encouraged to provide a donation in the envelopes provided at the self registration kiosk.
- Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground.
- Pets are permitted in the campground, but must be leashed and attended at all times.
- Cutting standing trees and shrubs and using power saws is prohibited.
- Do not wash dishes or brush teeth at water stations.
- This is a carry-in/carry-out park for all trash. Registered campers can bring trash to Moose Brook for disposal.
- 10 mph is the speed limit in the campground and all day-use areas.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. Please do not bring firewood from out-of-state locations.

### For Your Safety

Do not invite bears or raccoons into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site by disposing of food waste properly and securing all food items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.
