Camping Information

About the Campground

The campground is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend. First come/first served walk-ins are welcome.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

Flush toilets, coin-operated showers, and a camp store are offered.

Activities

Enjoy swimming, picnicking, and biking. Trout fishing is excellent in many nearby streams. The park is a great base for hiking in the Presidential Range and visiting Mt. Washington.

Making a Reservation

Reservations for organized youth group camping are required and should be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757. Youth Group reservations are not available online.

About the Policies

- Check-in time is between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11 am. Campers are welcome to use the day-use area for the remainder of the day.
- The park accepts cash, voucher, money order, Mastercard, Visa or Discover.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Pets are permitted in the campground only, not in the day-use area. Pets must be leashed and attended to at all times.
- Although there are no hook-ups, recreational vehicles are welcome in sites where they fit.
- Your camping permit must be presented at the day-use area for free swimming and picnicking. Swimming is permitted only when the day-use area is open.
- Pets and RVs are not permitted in youth group areas.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Recycling

Ask our staff about recycling in Moose Brook State Park. Thanks for keeping New Hampshire clean and green.
