DETAILS

Welcome to the New Hampshire State Parks 90th Anniversary Digital Scavenger Hunt (“Scavenger Hunt”). To celebrate the 90th anniversary of NH State Parks in 2025, the NH Division of Parks and Recreation has partnered with the Goosechase platform to host a scavenger hunt across various NH State Parks. The Participant must be able to download and use the [Goosechase App](#) on a mobile device to complete missions, tasks, and upload photos in order to participate. Each mission will be assigned points and each participant that completes a mission will be awarded points that may count toward winning a prize. Prizes may include stickers, t-shirts or other NH State Parks gear.

RULES

You must be 18 years old or older to participate. Many of our missions can be completed by answering trivia or by visiting a park that offers free entry. Some missions may be located at parks where an entry fee or ticket is required. Read full details on our official entry page.

OFFICIAL RULES

NH State Parks 90th Anniversary Digital Scavenger Hunt (the “Scavenger Hunt”)

- 1. CONTEST PERIOD:** The Scavenger Hunt begins on April 1, 2025 at 12:00:01 AM Eastern Time and ends on November 11, 2025 at 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time. NH State Parks reserves the right to end the Contest early or extend it if deemed necessary.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY:** The Scavenger Hunt is open to residents of the United States and Canada age eighteen (18) or older as of the date of entry. An active e-mail account, internet access, and the Goosechase Mobile App are required during the Contest Period. Employees of the State of New Hampshire’s Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, the immediate family members of such employees, and persons living in the same household of such employees, are not eligible to participate in the Contest. Participation in the Contest constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules (“Official Rules”). Subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.
- 3. TO ENTER:** To participate in the Scavenger Hunt, you must register through the Goosechase app and provide all necessary details, including your full name, email address, and any additional required information.

By registering, you agree to receive communications related to the Scavenger Hunt and New Hampshire State Parks’ 90th Anniversary celebration. Only one Goosechase account is allowed per person. Entrants submitting or creating multiple accounts or violating any of these Official Rules may be disqualified.

4. HOW TO PARTICIPATE: The Scavenger Hunt consists of a series of challenges, tasks, and clues that will be released periodically during the event. Participants will earn points by completing challenges and submitting proof of completion via the Goosechase app.

Challenges may include but are not limited to answering trivia questions, solving riddles, completing tasks at specific New Hampshire State Parks, and submitting photos or videos. Participants may earn bonus points by completing certain challenges early or in a creative way, as determined by New Hampshire State Parks.

5. SCAVENGER HUNT POINTS SYSTEM: Each challenge is worth a designated number of points. Points are awarded based on the successful completion of the challenge according to the rules provided. The number of points awarded may vary depending on the difficulty of the challenge. Points will be tracked through the Goosechase app, and Participants can view their scores at any time.

6. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to Participants based on their point totals at the end of the Scavenger Hunt. The number and value of prizes may vary, and New Hampshire State Parks reserves the right to alter the prize structure at its discretion. Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or other items.

7. NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS: Winners will be notified via the contact information provided during registration. Winners will be notified by e-mail within five (5) business days of the prize drawing and may be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility and publicity/liability release within seven (7) days of notification. If a selected winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim a prize and/or where applicable an affidavit of eligibility and publicity/liability release is not timely received, is incomplete or modified, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected from remaining valid, eligible entries timely submitted.

8. GENERAL RULES: By entering the Contest, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules. NH State Parks is not responsible for late, lost, delayed, damaged, postage-due, incomplete, illegible, misdirected or undeliverable entries, responses, or other correspondence, whether by e-mail or postal mail or otherwise; theft, destruction, unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials; or phone, electrical, network, computer, hardware, software program or transmission malfunctions, failures or difficulties.

By entering the Contest, you further agree to release, indemnify, defend and hold the NH Division of Parks and Recreation (“NH State Parks”) and the State of New Hampshire and its, affiliates, subsidiaries, directors, officers, employees, sponsors and agents, including advertising and promotion agencies, and assigns, and any other organizations related to the Contest, harmless, from any and all claims, injuries, damages, expenses or losses to person or property and/or liabilities of any nature that in any way arise from participation in this Contest or acceptance or use of a prize or parts thereof, including, without limitation, (i) any condition caused by events beyond NH State Parks control that may cause the Contest to be disrupted or corrupted; (ii) any injuries, losses, or damages (compensatory, direct, incidental, consequential or otherwise) of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the prize, or acceptance, possession, or use of the prize, or from participation in the Contest; and (iii) any printing or typographical errors in any materials associated with the Contest. Winners agree to be bound by these Official Rules, and NH State Parks decisions in all respects relative to the Contest are final.

The recipient is responsible for any income tax liability and should consult his/her tax advisor for the proper tax treatment of this income on his/her tax return.

9. PRIVACY LIMITED: The information submitted by you in connection with an entry will be used for administering your participation in the Contest and to contact you with information regarding NH State Parks and will not be sold or transferred to a third party.

Except where prohibited, by participating in the Contest, a participant consents to NH State Parks using his/her name, photo and/or likeness, biographical information, entry and statements reasonably attributed to the participant in NH State Parks advertising and promotional materials, including without limitation, inclusion in NH State Parks newsletters and on NH State Parks' website located at www.nhstateparks.org with consent to any such uses to be without consideration, compensation or otherwise.

All entries become property of NH State Parks, and none will be acknowledged or returned. Allow up to six (6) to eight (8) weeks for delivery of the prize.

NH State Parks reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, modify or suspend the Contest in whole or in part, in the event of fraud, technical or other difficulties or if the integrity of the Contest are compromised, without liability to the entrant. NH State Parks reserves the right to disqualify any entrant or winner, as determined by NH State Parks, in its sole discretion. The Contest is subject to these Official Rules and all applicable federal, state, provincial and local laws and regulations apply.

10. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT: By participating in this Contest, you acknowledge that you have read these Official Rules and agree to abide by them and by the decisions of NH State Parks, which are final and binding on all matters pertaining to the Contest. These Official Rules are governed by the law of the State of New Hampshire.
