	DIRECTIONAL MARKER 8" X 8" Extended Diamond – orange/black Used to show trail direction in areas where riders could venture off designated trail.		
	TRAIL BLAZE 5" X 7" Extended Diamond – orange/black Informs riders they are on a designated trail.		
NEW HAMPSHIRE SHOWHORLE CORRIDOR TRAIL SECTION:  FLAT SAFE AND THE SECTION  FLAT SAFE AND THE SECTION	CORRIDOR TRAIL 8" X 9" Rectangle – white/green Placed at entrances to corridor trails with the number and direction of travel printed in the white area with a paint pen.		
SNOWMOBILE PRIMARY TRAIL NEW HAMPSHIRE	PRIMARY TRAIL 7" X 7" Square – white/green Used to inform riders that the trail connects to a Corridor Trail. The number will correspond to the number on the NHSA Snowmobile Trail map.		
	Informational Signs		
TRAIL INFORMATION	TRAIL INFORMATION 6" X 8" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders of where they are, how far to gas, who maintains the trail, how far to parking, etc.		
STAY ON TRAIL OR STAY HOME	STAY ON TRAIL OR STAY HOME  6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black  Many landowners request riders to ride in a specific area.		
DEAD END DO NOT ENTER	DEAD END DO NOT ENTER  6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders that there is no outlet on trail; trail ends.		
STAY ON TRAIL OR LOSE IT	STAY ON TRAIL OR LOSE IT 6" X 12" Rectangle – orange/black Informs riders to stay on the trail or risk it being closed.		
TRAIL FUNDED BY REGISTRATION FEES	TRAIL HEAD  9" X 12" Diamond – white/green  Used when new trail is started, at the beginning of a trail from parking areas, or to indicate the trailhead across a large open field. Reminds riders that their registration fees pay for New Hampshire's Snowmobile trail system.		
TRAIL USERS THIS TRAILS OF PRIVATE LAND IT IS BENCHMORE AVAILABLE THROIGH THE COPPERATION OF:  AND HAS BEEN ROWTHOPED THROIGH THE EFFORTS OF:  BO VOT LITTLE BENY WITH CORE RESPECT PRIVATE PROPERTY	LANDOWNERS 12" X 12" Square – white/black Used as a public relations tool between clubs and landowners. Advises trail users that they are on private property and should "RESPECT IT."		
TRAIL PARKING	TRAIL PARKING TO LEFT  12" X 24" Rectangle – white/green  Placed at the entrance to approved parking areas. Informs riders to go to the left to reach OHRV parking.		
TRAIL PARKING	TRAIL PARKING TO RIGHT  12" X 24" Rectangle – white/green  Placed at the entrance to approved parking areas. Informs riders to go to the right to reach OHRV parking.		

Warning Signs			
	STOP AHEAD  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black/red  Informs riders that they are approaching a STOP sign.		
TRAIL TEMPORARILY CLOSED	TRAIL TEMPORARILY CLOSED Note: this sign is limited to 5/club/year.  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders that they are approaching a temporarily closed area and should not proceed.	Limit to 5 max	
CAUTION GATE AHEAD	GATE AHEAD  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down as they are approaching a gate across the trail.		
CAUTION BRIDGE AHEAD	BRIDGE AHEAD  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down as they are approaching a bridge crossing.		
CAUTION LOGGING AHEAD	LOGGING AHEAD  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down, could encounter heavy equipment & trucks.		
JUNCTION	JUNCTION AHEAD  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders to slow down, a trail junction is up ahead.		
<b>→</b>	RIGHT or LEFT TURN 12" X 12" Square – yellow/black Informs riders that the trail ahead makes significant changes in direction.		
SLOW	SLOW 12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Instructs riders to slow their vehicle.		
PLANTATION	PLANTATION  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders they are entering a tree plantation and should stay on the trail.		
	WATCH FOR GROOMERS  12" X 12" Diamond – yellow/black Informs riders they should be aware of groomers being used on the trail.		
	OBJECT (Hazard) MARKER 7" X 7" Square – yellow/black. Identifies a fixed object at the side of the trail. (Used any time the fixed object narrows the normal width of trail.
