Headquarters Campground Information

About the Campground

The campground is open year-round; however amenities and services from November through April are limited.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

A camp store, flush toilets, and coin-operated showers are available in the campground during the regular season. From November through April, the campground road is not plowed in winter and visitors must hike their gear to their site. Showers are closed, but water and flush toilets are available year-round at the main bathhouse.

About the Policies

- Check-in time is between 1 pm and 8 pm.
Check-out time is 11 am.
- Visitors must pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Pets are strictly prohibited in all areas of the park at all times.
- Firewood may be purchased at the store. It is against the law to peel birch bark, cut trees, shrubs, or branches. Only loose wood on the ground that will completely fit in the fire ring may be scavenged.
- Sort recycling and deposit at the recycling station located at the tollbooth. Sorted trash will be accepted (from campers).
- Do not wash dishes in the bathroom sinks or brush teeth or wash dishes at the water stations. There are dishwashing sinks outside the showers during the main season.
- Park in designated area only. Do not move barriers or park vehicles on the tent location.
- If the campground office is closed, simply register and pay appropriate fee in the morning.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).Monadn

Activities

Many of the trails that lead to the 3,165 foot summit of popular Mt. Monadnock start near the Headquarters Campground. Unsurpassed 100-mile views to points in all six New England states are the reward for a strenuous climb. Approximately 40 miles of maintained foot trails provide a variety of hiking opportunities. Approximately 8 miles of trail system in the lower elevations offer great ski touring for the experienced cross country skier.

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Making a Reservation

Reservations for organized youth group camping are required and should be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757. Off-season youth group reservations can be done through the Park Office at (603) 532-8862. Youth group reservations are not available online.

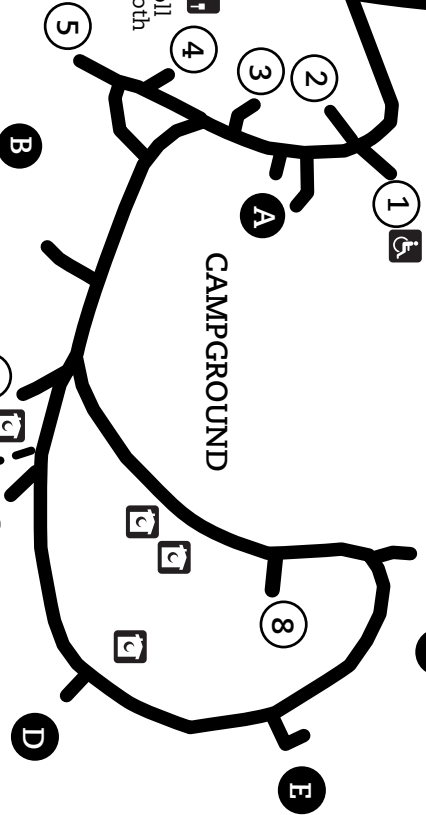
