Summary:

Operates, maintains, and repairs a variety of snow grooming equipment, heavy earth moving equipment, trucks, ATVs, snowmobiles, and other maintenance/repair equipment. Constructs and maintains snowmobile, ATV, and multi-use trails on all type terrain over one third of the state.

Responsibilities:

Winter

Works alone operating sophisticated hydraulic snow grooming equipment and related attachments and or accessories i.e. Tucker 2000 sno cats, track truck 2800 groomers, various size bombardier groomers, snowmobiles etc. alone, on various terrains, to include remote mountainous trails, day and or night.

Makes adjustments and emergency repairs in the field to equipment to get equipment off the trail.

Summer

Operates sophisticated hydraulic earth moving equipment, trucks, and ATVs i.e. excavators, bulldozers, road graders, dump trucks, 3 and 4 wheel ATVs etc. on all types of terrain from flat to remote mountainous areas.

Assists in layout, clearing and construction of snowmobile, ATV, and multi-use trails to include tree cutting, bulldozing, bridge design/construction, and seeding disturbed areas.

Perform welding repairs, modification and construction of grooming attachments.

Supervises, trains, instructs, and advises mountain equipment operator trainees; instructs, advises, and partial supervision over clubs, personnel, volunteers, and shock incarceration unit personnel on specialized projects.

Performs continuous maintenance on trails i.e. cutting brush, cleaning culverts, opening beaver dams, grading, constructing and or repairing gates, repairing, and replacing or constructing bridges.

Secures and maintains all assigned tools and equipment.

Minimum qualifications:

Education: Graduation from high school, G.E.D. or its equivalent.

Experience: Two years experience in operating and maintaining snow and trail conditioning equipment, including snowgrooming tractors, bulldozers, front end loaders, ATVs and other types of heavy equipment.

LICENSE and or CERTIFICATION Must possess a valid driver's license to operate the equipment mentioned in supplemental job description.
