Ethnobotany

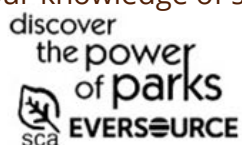
Learn about the complex reciprocal relationships between New Hampshire's Abenaki people and the state's native plants outside the visitor's center.
