Highlights of the SPECIAL PROVISIONS of your club's Grant-In-Aid Agreement

1. Clubs receiving GIA funds for grooming are required to fill out a Grooming Log and submit one copy for each instance of grooming along with a completed Billing Form by the 10th of the month following the month the grooming was completed in. For example, January grooming/plowing should be submitted to BOT by February 10th.

2. Operational hour meters are required on Class 3, 4 and 5 machines.

3. Between December 15th and January 1st, there must be eight inches (8") of continuous snow on the ground before clubs can begin grooming operations.
