Camping Information

About the Campground

The campground is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

A camp store, coin-operated showers, dump station, playground, ice and firewood are available. Boat rentals are available on Memorial Day weekend and July through August.

Activities

Enjoy trout fishing, swimming, canoeing, and hiking. Boats are not to exceed trolling speed.

About the Policies

- All campers, including those with reservations, must register at the campground office between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11 am.
- Only two vehicles are allowed per campsite, including visitor vehicles. Overflow parking is available at the main parking lot by the registration office.
- Payment is due upon registration and must be U.S. funds. Cash, credit card or traveler's checks accepted.
- The license plate number is needed to register.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 7 am. No loud radios.
- Pets are not allowed in the park.
- The beach is open during daylight hours only.
- Campers must dispose of trash daily at the dumpster location, across from the Registration Office. This dumpster is for campers only.
- Do not wash dishes or brush teeth at the outside water stations. Do not wash dishes in the bathroom sinks. There is a dish wash station in Area 2.
- Cutting standing trees or shrubs and using power saws is prohibited.
- 1 RV or Pop-up Trailer with an additional 3 cars are allowed in the group area.
- If the campground office is closed, registration at the self-registration station is required. Provide the requested information on the envelope provided, enclose the fee, and deposit in the designated slot.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Feeding the ducks attracts large numbers to the swimming area where they become a health concern.

Making a Reservation

Reservations may be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757 or online at nhstateparks.org. Reservations for organized youth group camping are required and should be made by calling NH State Parks Headquarters at (603) 271-3556, option 1. Youth group reservations are not available online.
