Pillsbury State Park Camping Information

About the Campground

The primitive campground is open for reservable stays from Memorial Day weekend through Columbus Day weekend.

Facilities, Services and Amenities

Water, pit toilets, a playground, kayak and canoe rentals, boat launch (for non-motorized boats), and firewood are available. Eleven of the 41 campsites are remote and accessible by foot or canoe only. Rental boats may be reserved by calling the park directly. All pit toilets are handicap accessible.

Activities

Enjoy canoeing, warm-water fishing, and hiking. The 51mile Monadnock-Sunapee Greenway traverses the park lands.

About the Policies

- All campers, including those with a reservation, must register at the campground office between 1 pm and 8 pm. Check-out time is 11 am.
- Payment is due upon registration and may be made by cash, voucher, money order, or traveler's check only. Credit cards and personal checks are not accepted.
- Visitors are required to pay the day-use fee and may visit in the campground during posted visitor hours.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Bring trash and recycling to the recycling station.
- Pets are permitted but must be leashed and attended to at all times, and must be picked up after.
- Cutting standing trees and shrubs and using power saws is prohibited.
- Your camping permit may be presented at nearby Mt. Sunapee State Beach for free picnicking and swimming.
- RVs are not permitted in youth group areas.
- Firewood is a major carrier of exotic insects and tree diseases. It is unlawful to bring firewood from out-of-state locations. (RSA 227-K:17).
- Speed limit is 15mph in park.

For Your Safety

Do not invite wildlife into the campground or to your campsite. Keep a clean site, dispose of food waste properly and secure all food and heavily scented items in your vehicle at night. Coolers left out are easily opened by raccoons or destroyed by bears.

Reservations may be made by calling ReserveAmerica at 1-877-647-2757, or online at nhstateparks.org. Youth group camping reservations are not available online.
