

Connecticut Lakes Headwaters

Ponds, Lakes, and Streams with Public Access

Note: Areas are subject to road closures.

Boundary Pond: Near Snag and Rhubarb Ponds. 18 acres. Fly fishing only.
No motors.

Carr Pond: Lake Francis area. 10 acres. Brook trout. Walk in.

Coon Brook Pond: 45 acres. Fly fishing only.

East Inlet: 43 acres. Trout waters. Trailer parking.

Judd Pond: Near Shehan Pond and Pisgah Mountain.

Lake Francis: Lake Francis State Park area. 2082 acres. Lake trout and salmon waters. Trailer parking.

Sheehan Pond: The beginning of Roby Brook leading to the Dead Diamond River. 20 acres. Brook trout. Walk in.

Terrill Pond: On the west branch of Indian Stream. 10 acres. Brook trout.
Fly fishing only.

Third Connecticut Lake: 289 acres. Cartop parking.

Unknown Pond: Between Coon and Big Brook Bogs. Brook trout. Walk in.

Connecticut River: Beginning at the Canadian Border, the river flows through the Connecticut Lakes. Walk in and roadside access.

Perry Stream: Excellent cold water fishing.

Indian Stream: Excellent cold water fishing.

Deadwater Stream: Excellent cold water fishing.
