Predator & Prey Drawing activity

Now it's your turn to draw your own predator and prey animals! Choose a prey or a predator animal (or both!), then roll a die to see which skills it will use to live in the wild! If you roll a three, choose option three from the list below. If you don't have a die, choose your favorite option! PREY PREDATOR

- 1. Hides deep in snow to avoid its predator
- 2. Can freeze in place to fool its predator
- 3. Has a tail that it uses to defend itself from predators
- 4. Dives deep under the water to avoid its predator
- 5. Avoids its predator by climbing up trees
- 6. Jumps large distances to avoid its predator

- 1. Hunts deer in woods on an island
- 2. Hunts fish in a fast flowing stream
- 3. Runs long distances to catch its prey
- 4. Climbs trees quickly to catch its prey
- 5. Hears its prey moving from far away
- 6. Tunnels into the ground to catch its prey

Remember the different adaptations that each type of animal has to help it survive, and that prey and predator animals can be any shape and size! At the bottom of each box, write a description for how you designed your animal and answer the following questions.

If you make a prey animal, answer... How will your prey avoid predators? Where will it live? Where should its eyes be placed?

If you make a predator animal, answer... How will your predator catch prey? Where will it live? Where should its eyes be placed?
