NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE PARKS SEASON PASS PROGRAM



Thank you for supporting New Hampshire State Parks with the purchase of a Season Pass!

For guaranteed access to any day-use park with a pass pictured above:

For 100% guaranteed access to a park, we do advise you to purchase an advance reservation, as the parks will fill up quickly. The cost is a non-refundable \$1 reservation fee provided you select the pass you intend on using upon entrance into the park. Also, to ensure accurate account information associated with the pass, please update your Reserve America account information to reflect any address change.

NEW THIS YEAR: Expiration and renewal:

All passes will expire 365 days from the purchase/renew date. You can renew your pass up to 4 months prior and any time after your current expiration date. You will not receive a new pass upon renewal. Renew by visiting: https://www.nhstateparks.org/planning/schedule-and-fees/passes-promotions.

How to use the pass and the fine print:

- The pass-holder **must** present the pass and a valid photo ID at the park entrance for verification purposes. If the pass is not presented at the park upon entrance, you will be required to pay the standard rate for entrance.
- The pass is only valid for day-use admission.
- The pass is not valid for parking meters, Hampton Beach State Park South Beach or Wallis Sands. (The two oceanfront parks charging a vehicle fee), and is not valid at attractions such as the Flume Gorge or Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway.
- The pass is not valid for retail purchases, camping and applicable fees, permits, enterprise functions, or rental of function space.
- The pass may not be used in combination with any other discounts or promotions.
- The pass does not guarantee admission into an area where facilities are full to capacity, as determined by State Park staff.
- The pass is non-refundable, non-transferable, and may not be redeemed for cash.
- NH State Parks and affiliates are not responsible for replacing a lost, stolen, or revoked passes.

Persons attempting to gain admission without a pass in hand and valid photo ID will be charged all applicable admission fees.
